

Fire extinguisher maintenance checklist

It's important to visually inspect your fire extinguishers on a regular basis so that they are ready for use in the event of a fire.

| Are your fire extinguishers in their designated locations? I.e. hung on the wall, in their stand, aligned with appropriate signage? | | | | |

| Are there any signs of tampering? I.e. are the tamper indicators and seals intact? | | | | |

| Is the pressure rating on the pressure gauge or indicator on the extinguisher within the safety limit? | | | | |
| Is there any damage to the extinguisher? This could be in the form of missing parts, dents, rust, scratches or gouges on the cylinder, excessive dirt on valves and pressure gauges, corrosion or leakages, clogged nozzle or wand (wet chemical extinguishers), frayed or split hose, cracked or split horn (CO2 extinguishers) | | | | |
